STOWMARKET BURY ROAD MAIN REPLACEMENT

We are improving the sewerage network in Stowmarket by installing a new 2164m sewage pipeline from Stowmarket Town Football Club, along Bury Road, Gipping Way, Navigation Approach and Tomo Road, to our Water Recycling Centre, off Gun Cotton Way.

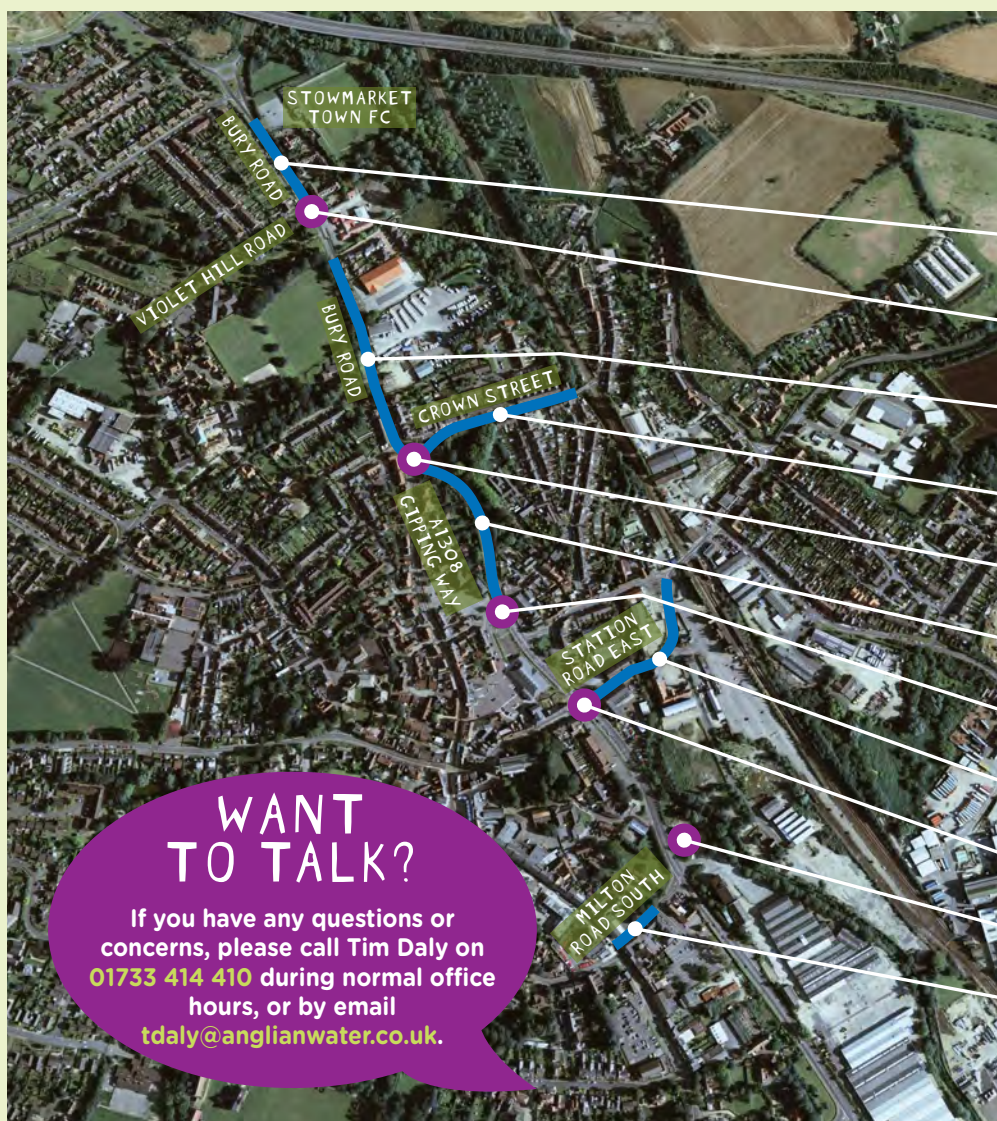
Work is scheduled to start on Monday 27th June 2016 and is due to complete in December 2016.

The pipeline route goes through the town and we have worked with Suffolk County Council to use appropriate traffic management ensuring the safety of our workforce and the public whilst minimising disruption to commuters, residents and businesses. The necessary road closures are shown below.

BACKGROUND

As part of our on-going investment programme to improve the service we provide to our customers, we are planning to carry out £1.1 million improvements to the sewerage network in Stowmarket.

The town has suffered multiple pipeline bursts over several years causing flooding to properties, risking pollution and disruption to rail services.
