Thank you for your request for information about capacity at Wymondham, which we received on 23 February 2026. Your request has been considered under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 (EIR).

You requested:

1. The location Wymondham Water Recycling Works
2. Where the works discharges
3. Does it receive flow from combined sewers
4. Does Wymondham Water Recycling Works have capacity to cope with new developments

EIR Response: Partial Provision & Partial Refusal of Requested Information

Item 1 is held by Anglian Water and has been partially provided below.

Wymondham WRC is situated to the North East of Wymondham at grid ref TG0902.

In your request you have asked for the exact location. This has not been disclosed. The exception applied is: regulation 12(5)(a) of the EIR, International relations, defence, national security or public safety. Disclosure would adversely affect public safety.

Wastewater treatment works are an important part of our network, disclosing the precise location of these critical sites would undermine safety. While we do not believe you have requested this information for this purpose, disclosure under EIR is to the world, and therefore the information would be widely available.

Item 2 is held by Anglian Water and has been provided below.

The WRC discharges Final Effluent into the River Tiffey.

Item 3 is held by Anglian Water and has been provided below.

Wymondham WRC does receive flows from combined sewers.

Item 4 is held by Anglian Water and has been provided below.

With regard to planning application 2025/2176 for 110 dwellings at Croft Way (AW reference: PLN-0230653), from the details submitted to support the planning application, the proposed method of surface water management does not relate to Anglian Water operated assets. Please see the Flood Risk Assessment documents on the Local Planning Authority website for further details:

Therefore, we would not anticipate any additional surface water being received by our WRC should the proposed development gain planning approval.

Should the proposed method of surface water management change to include interaction with Anglian Water operated assets, we have requested to be re-consulted by the Local Planning Authority to ensure that an effective surface water drainage strategy is prepared and implemented.

The current surface water discharge proposals are within the remit of the Lead Local Flood Authority (LLFA) for comment.
